



Alpine Skiing – Selection criteria for World Junior Ski Championship, St. Anton (AUT)

Eligibility

- Athletes with a valid FIS code born 2002-2006

Quota

- Each nation may participate with 4 athletes per discipline (+ZK quota)
- Maximum team size is 12 competitors (max 8 per gender)

SSF Criteria

Athletes born 2002

In the age group - top 25 in 1 discipline and top 35 in 2nd discipline or avg. top 27 in two best disciplines of which at least 1 discipline is tech

Athletes born 2003

In the age group - top 25 in 1 discipline and top 35 in 2nd discipline or avg. top 27 in two best disciplines of which at least 1 discipline is tech

Athletes 2004-2006

In the age group (2 years) - top 20 in 1 discipline and top 30 in 2nd discipline or avg. top 22 in two best disciplines of which at least 1 discipline is tech

FIS list no 14 (22/23) is used (results until 8.1.2023)

Team size is limited to 4(5) athletes per gender. Should more than 4 athletes per gender are in the criteria -> Coaches evaluation;

1. Results of 21/22 (priority WC – COC - FIS)
2. Ability to perform in at least 2 disciplines (Avg fis points of 2 best results in 2 disciplines in 21/22 will be evaluated)
3. Athlete long term development plan

SSF analysis and selection committee includes National Team Head Coaches, Sport Director and / or Chief Executive + a board member.
